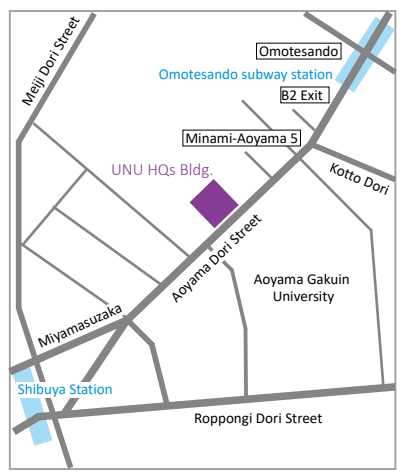

UNIDO promotes industrial development for poverty reduction, inclusive globalization and environmental sustainability.

UNIDO is headquartered in Vienna, Austria, has 5 Regional office hubs, 4 Regional offices, 39 Country offices, 3 Liaison offices in Brussels, Geneva and New York, Investment & Technology Promotion offices in 9 cities, and other types of offices worldwide, through which various services are provided.
