We stand before an ambitious agenda of change and unprecedented challenges induced by COVID-19. Achieving the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), adhering to the 1.5°C climate limit and saving millions of species from extinction — while reaching those excluded from economic growth — requires addressing the root causes of unsustainable development. Economic transformation can grow jobs, income and prosperity when driven by solution-oriented policies and investments. Economic recovery from COVID-19 can be transformational — policy and investment efforts to revive and stimulate growth will determine if future threats to human wellbeing,

to prosperity and to the health of the planet are mitigated or amplified.

PAGE brings together the specialized expertise of five United Nations agencies and aims to accelerate a sustainability revolution and green and inclusive economic transformation, including through recovery efforts. The partnership offers a comprehensive, coordinated and cost-effective package of:

- Economic and scientific analytical tools;
- Technical assistance for policy development, and;
- Capacity-building services for policy implementation.

The PAGE Offer

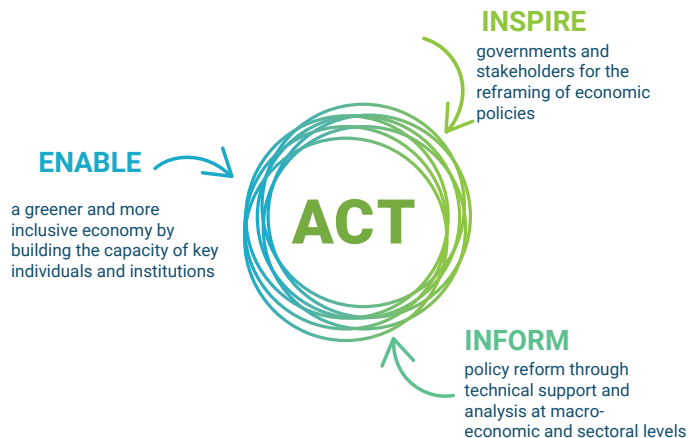
PAGE services are tailored to the unique starting points, needs and circumstances of each partner country to help develop its own pathway to a job-rich green recovery and an inclusive green economy.

Green Recovery Support

- Provide platforms for inspiring action.



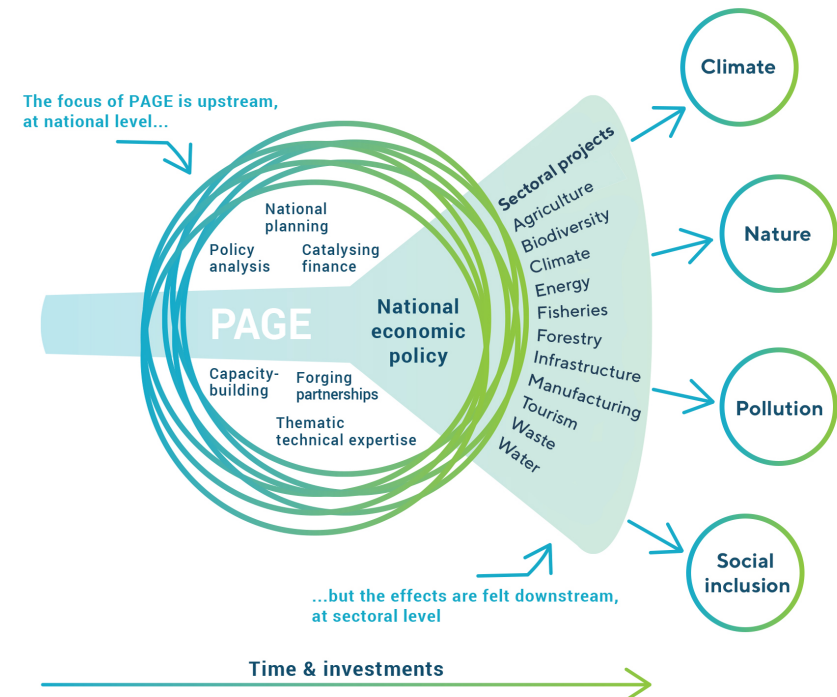
Linking to SDGs

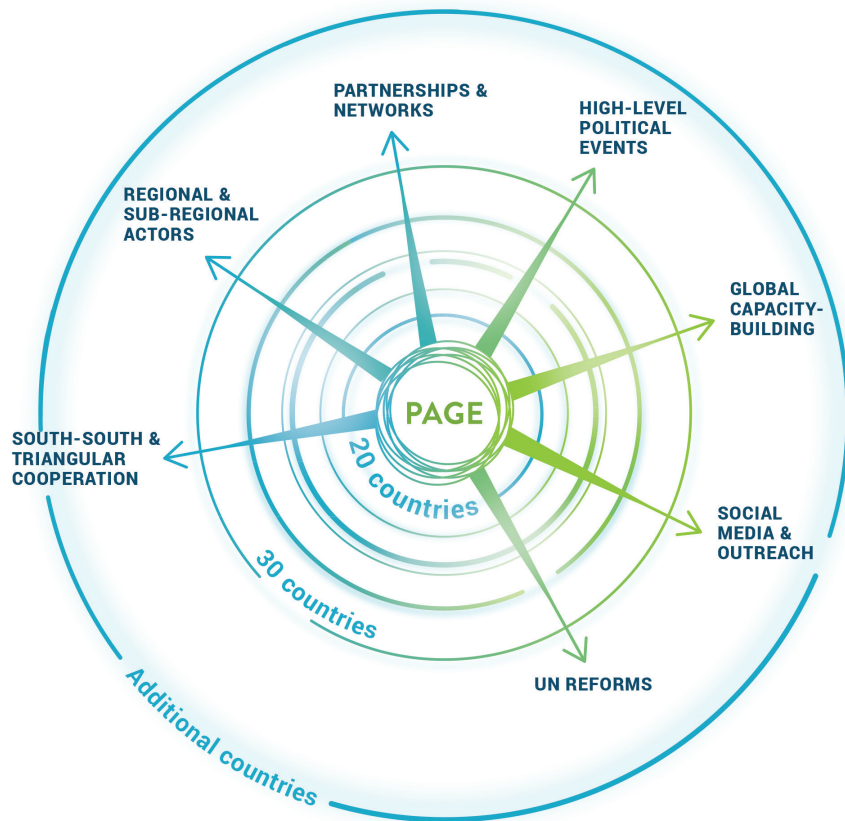
Areas of Action

PAGE has prioritized the following “impact scalars”. These scalars build on elements of the Global Services Package and respond to global and regional opportunities, as well as emerging megatrends that offer new pathways for change.



Guiding Principles for PAGE Country Engagement

COUNTRY OWNERSHIP

All processes are driven by key ministries, in cooperation with national stakeholders, and are supported by PAGE.

MULTI-MINISTERIAL ENGAGEMENT

Activities are initiated in countries where key ministries have jointly expressed interest in collaborating with PAGE.

LINKAGES WITH NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLANNING

PAGE support is connected with the existing structures and processes for long-term sustainability.

PROGRAMMATIC AND POLICY FOCUS

Specialized technical assistance is provided on strategic policy analysis and macroeconomic, sectoral and thematic policy development.

MULTI-STAKEHOLDER ENGAGEMENT

Key stakeholder groups and societal partners are engaged in the planning and delivery of PAGE services.

JOINT COMMITMENT FOR RESULTS

Governments and PAGE partners work together based on a collective commitment to achieve sustainable growth for all.



Engage with PAGE

PAGE Partner Country

PAGE partner countries receive technical and policy support for a transition toward an inclusive green economy, which includes support to 'build better forward' from COVID-19. The key selection criteria for prospective partner countries include:

- Demonstrated high-level commitment of the country to a transition to green economy.
- A clear demand for technical assistance.
- Linkages between requested support and national planning processes.
- Evidence of inter-ministerial coordination.
- Readiness for multi-stakeholder engagement.

PAGE Funding Partner

PAGE funding partners contribute to the PAGE Trust Fund and:

- Provide overall strategic guidance.
- Advise in the selection of new PAGE countries.
- Review annual progress reports and suggest corrective actions.
- Ensure that independent evaluations are carried out and recommendations are addressed.
